

Vortex[®] Assembly Instructions

Do not attempt to snap the Vortex[®] together unless it is at room temperature.

Step 1) Snap the cover onto the bottom of the base similar to a lid on a butter bowl.

Step 2) Place the funnel upside down on a table or on the floor. Slip the base onto the snout of the cone and apply force in a circular rocking motion until it “snaps” into place. No gap should remain. Alternately, you can hold the funnel against your chest and “pull” the base onto the cone while rocking it in a circular motion until it snaps.

Step 3) Snap the coin ramps onto the rim of the funnel over the two small bumps on opposite sides of the top of the rim. Position the notches on the underside of the ramp-legs over the bumps on the funnel rim. You will need to stretch the feet of the ramps apart slightly in order to fit over the rim, then snap them into place.

That’s it! Now, let the coin-spinning fun begin!

The simplest way to have fun is to place coins near the top of the ramps and let them slide down the curved chutes. You can also roll marbles, ball bearings, or any other round object.



Skill Challenges...

Try tossing coins in without the ramps to see if you can get them to land at the correct angle and speed. This takes practice but is not difficult to learn

Coin Limbo

With the Vortex[®] flat on a table, let the coin descend down the funnel and then try to make it climb back up by rotating the Vortex[®] in a circular motion creating your own centrifugal force. See how low you can let the coin go and still have the skill to bring it back up. You can even make the coin spin around the top edge with eye-blurring speed by moving the Vortex[®] in a circular motion to create high-speed centrifugal force as shown in the above picture.
